Safety is really important to us, and our contractor, Brenig Construction. They will do everything they can to make their works as safe as possible this summer. While construction sites can look fun and exciting places to play, they post serious risks and are not adventure playgrounds.



For further safety arrangements, & to keep everyone safe, the site has been installed with a number of 'Daleks', which are remotely monitored cameras, these are motion sensitive. They will take images of anyone who activates them after the site has closed for the day.

Whilst Brenig Construction take every reasonable precaution to ensure the site is secure and safe, we need your help! We'd like to ask your help in keeping children and young people in the local community safe over the summer around our construction site.

Please could you help us make sure everyone stays safe by:

- Reminding others of the need to keep out of construction sites.
- Helping others think about dangers that exist on construction sites.
- Reporting anyone you see playing on the construction site, climbing on equipment, fences etc. You can do this by calling 101.
- Hazards and risks to be aware of include, but not exclusive to:
  - o Scaffolding
  - o Falls from heights
  - Plant and machinery
  - Excavations
